

Kisspeptin-10 Dosing Chart

A peptide that triggers the hormonal cascade leading to reproductive hormone release. Studied in humans for fertility and reproductive function. Commonly discussed doses: 100 mcg–800 mcg. Research protocols use weight-based dosing administered by infusion or injection. Figures shown are reference points in micrograms. There is no established or approved dose.
