A branded supplier blend, typically combining the anti-inflammatory peptide KPV with GHK-Cu and repair peptides. Composition varies and is unregulated. Commonly discussed doses: 1 mg–5 mg. KLOW blends have no standardized composition — amounts vary by supplier. Figures shown are reference points only and do not describe a studied product. Dosing depends entirely on the specific formulation.
